


Please take the time to read this measurement sheet carefully. It will provide you with all the information you will need to properly measure your dog. This will provide a more comfortable fit for you and your dog.

#1 GIRTH MEASUREMENT

Measure the distance around your dog's body. Note: Measure at least 1" to 2" behind your dog's lowest point on his rib cage. This measurement will also help determine the size of the harness saddle.

#2 WIDTH OF DOG'S SHOULDERS

Measure the distance between your dog's shoulders. This is done by placing your dog against a wall and placing a straight edge on the outside shoulder. Then measure the distance between the wall and the straight edge. **This is a very important measurement, so please try to get an accurate measurement.**

#3 SIDE BREAST STRAP

Measure from the center of your dog's withers to half the length of the #2 measurement. (If your dog measures, lets sat 10" wide, then measure down 5" from his backbone over his shoulder area.) At the 5" mark, measure to the dog's chest bone. (See drawing above) This measurement will give you the side strap measurement,

#4 BREAST PLATE BOTTOM STRAP

Measure from the lowest point fo your dog's rib cage to the center of the dog chest bone. (See drawing above)

#5 HANDLE HEIGHT

Measure the distance in inches from your dog's back bone to the bottom of your palm. (See picture above) Please make sure you are standing straight with your elbow slightly bent in a comfortable position. For adjustable height handles, please supply only 3 measurement, no more than 1" apart and only 3" of adjustment up or down. Note: Handles over 10" in height, please add \$15.00 extra to the harness cost.

#6 EXTRA D RINGS

The standard harness comes with a D ring located in the middle of the saddle. (see saddle picture above) Extra d rings can be added any where you like at an additional cost of \$5.00 each.

#7 HELPFUL ADDED MEASUREMENTS

The height and weight of your dog is helpful when making your harness, but is not a required measurement.

PLEASE NOTE: I personally guarantee the fit and comfort of all my dog harnesses. I will gladly rework a Harness at no charge other than shipping both ways until you are satisfied with the harness. Note, as long as you measured your dog properly. If the measurements are wrong, you will be charged for any extra materials and work. PLEASE NOTE: I ship everything PRIORITY MAIL with tracking. If you do not insure your harness, I will not be responsible for lost packages!! Harness insurance cost \$7.00 more, see pricing page.
